OUR PROGRAMS



Ronald McDonald House®

A welcoming place to stay and supporting services for families whose children tend to be the sickest, have traveled the furthest distances for care and spend the longest time in the hospital. The House is more than a place to sleep; it is a place of comfort, compassion, and convenience for families dealing with the fear and anguish of a critically ill or injured child. Families can stay for a week, a few months or even longer. Ronald McDonald House programs also ease some of the emotional and financial burden that families face by offering meals, communal groceries and laundry services, and family-centered spaces where guests relax and refresh, and engage with staff and community volunteers in activities, such as arts & crafts, gardening, movie nights, games and other activities.



Ronald McDonald Care Mobile®

Removing barriers that prevent children from accessing medical and/or dental care in under-served and under-resourced communities. Our Ronald McDonald Care Mobile programs, in partnership with MedStar Georgetown University Hospital, provide services ranging from primary care, diagnosis, treatment, referral and follow-up for medical and dental conditions, as well as an innovative nutrition and exercise curriculum to children for children and their families.



Ronald McDonald Hospitality Cart

Extending care to families at the bedside of their hospitalized child, our Ronald McDonald Hospitality Carts provide amenities and comfort to parents and other caregivers. Several times a day, volunteers make "rounds" on the pediatric units of our partner hospitals with a well-stocked hospitality cart, offering complimentary snacks, toiletries, activities, toys, and more. The bright and cheerful cart is a welcome sight and another way RMHCDC provides comfort to families during a difficult time.

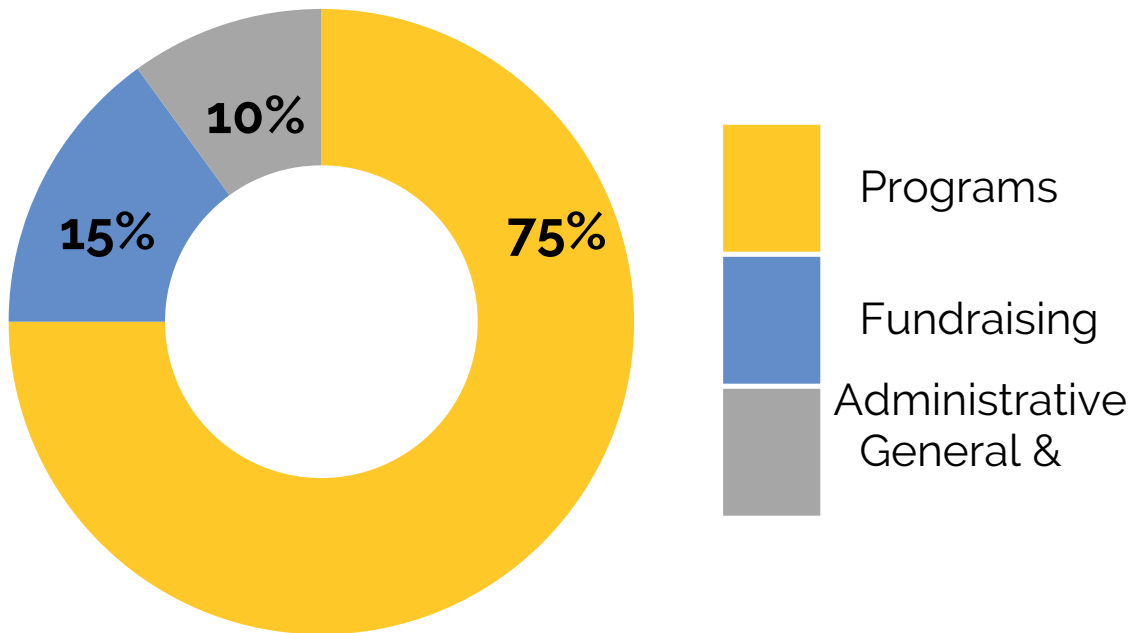

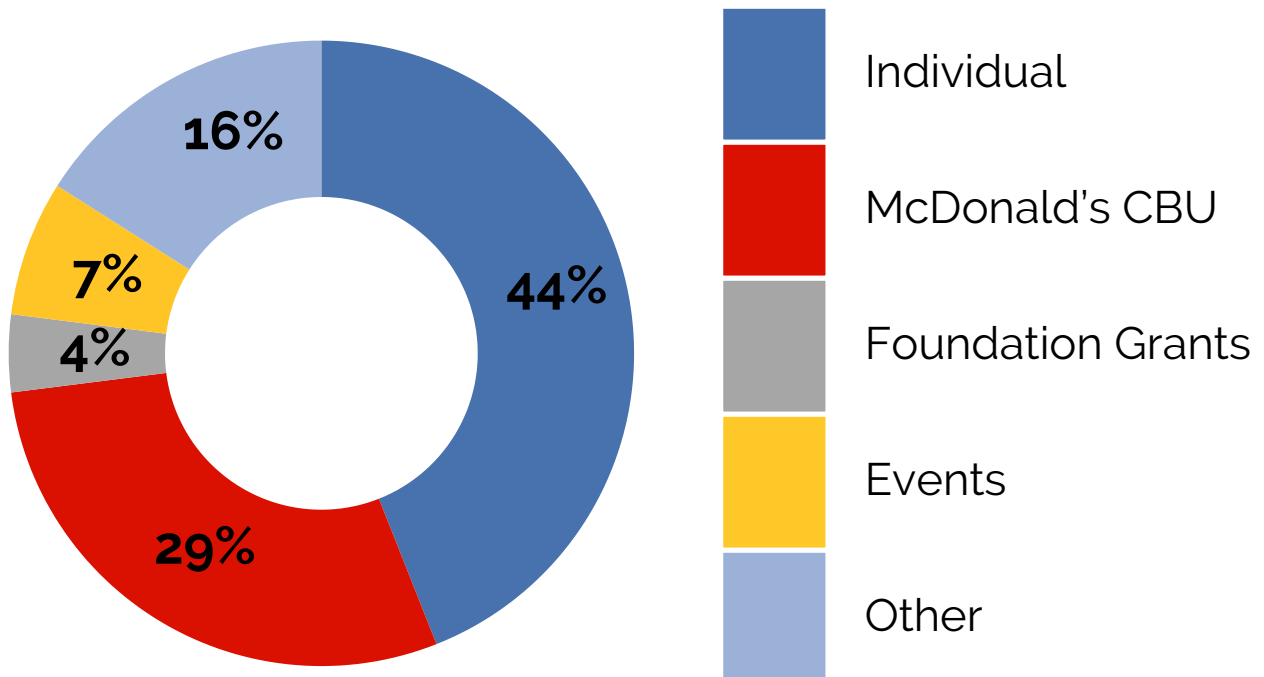
2022 FINANCIAL SNAPSHOT
