Ronald McDonald House programs also ease some of the emotional and financial burden that families face by offering meals, communal groceries and laundry services, and family-centered spaces where guests relax and refresh and engage with staff and community volunteers.

Red Shoe 5k

The Red Shoe 5k has been the cornerstone of RMHCDC's community events for 13 years, bringing together families, friends, and supporters near and far in support of our mission. In 2023, the run was held on October 7 at the National Harbor waterfront. We saw over 550 in-person participants, 70 virtual runners, 60 volunteers, and raised over \$115,000 for our programs. Kayden's mom shared this heartwarming sentiment:



"Not all hero's wear capes... but ours does. Our miracle fighter baby Kayden completed his first 5k to help other families, like ours, with hospitalized babies. Kayden spent his first 74 days on life support as he was born 11 weeks premature. My husband, Steven, was able to stay close by and care for us both because of the generosity of the Ronald McDonald House. We will forever be grateful."



RMHCDC Impact Fund

RMHCDC is built on the simple truth that nothing else should matter when a family is focused on healing their child – not where they can afford to stay, where they will get their next meal, or where they access care.

To raise critical funds and continue building capacity for greater impact, the Built By Love campaign was launched in 2022. We successfully unlocked and surpassed our initial goal of meeting a generous \$25,000 grant from the McDonald's of Washington, D.C., Baltimore, and Eastern Shore!

Building on the positive response to this campaign, in 2023, we have adapted it into the Built By Love Impact Fund. This fund will support further growth of our services, optimize our family-centered care, and build on our 40+ year commitment to the Greater Washington, DC area.

The Built By Love Impact Fund supports operating expenses to ensure that families receive the support they need, when they need it most. From a "home-away-from-home" for families while seeking pediatric care miles from home to stress-free access to all their basic needs at no cost.

As we look to what we can accomplish in 2024, it is vital that we continue to raise support for the Built By Love Impact Fund, as the main source of operating revenue.
