Peggy and Brett, first found out something was wrong with their daughter Winnie during her 20-week ultra-

sound. Tests revealed that Winnie had Down syndrom, and only 3 chambers in her heart, instead of 4.

After Winnie was born, they had to travel hours from home to Children's National Hospital to get her the heart surgery she needed to survive.

They didn't know how they would be by Winnie's side during her surgery and recovery while also caring for their 4-year old. During this time, when they needed each other most, splitting up the family didn't feel like an option.

When Peggy and Brett found out they could stay at our Ronald McDonald House, they were relieved they could be together. Peggy said, "Ronald McDonald House became our 'home-away-fromhome' where we could get away from the revolving door of medical staff and beeping machines."

Thanks to supporters like our Loyal Hearts Society, a room, daily necessities, and access to the care they needed were available when Winnie's family needed them most.

Less than a month later, Winnie underwent a 4-hour surgery to patch 2 holes in her heart and it was a success! She recovered in just 5 days – half the time expected. Peggy said, "Knowing we were a 5-minute drive to the hospital gave me invaluable peace of mind that we could 'come home' and take care of ourselves in order to be stronger the next day for our daughter."
